HELENA, CA until the hour of 10:00 a.m., on February 12, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud at City Hall, 1480 Main Street, St. Helena, California.**

**A mandatory pre-bid meeting and site inspection of the park will be held on February 1, 2010 at CRANE PARK, 360 CRANE AVENUE, ST. HELENA, CA.**

Bidders are hereby notified that pursuant to California Labor Code Sections 1770 et seq., the City Council of the City of St. Helena has adopted the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the rates for legal holiday and overtime work for the locality in which the work is to be performed, for each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to perform the Contract, as determined by the State Director of The Department of Industrial Relations. Prevailing wage information may be viewed at [www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD/index.hem](http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD/index.hem). The successful bidders shall pay not less than such prevailing rates.

Each proposal must conform and be responsive to this Notice, and shall be made on the official proposal form furnished with the specifications. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bank certified or cashier's check or satisfactory corporate surety bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the proposal and made payable to the City of St. Helena.

The City of St. Helena reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to determine which Proposal is, in its opinion, the lowest Bid of a responsible Bidder and in the best interest of the City to accept. The City Council also reserves the right to waive any informalities not material to cost or performance in such Proposals or Bids. The basis for comparing Bids will be the total cost.

Bidders shall possess a C27 license at the time the bid is submitted.  
All proposals shall be valid for a minimum period of forty-five (45) days after the bid opening.
